

Are you easy to talk to you? Are you a good listener? Open communication is essential for a healthy home life. This topic is important for emotional stability and growth.

Did you know that most adolescents who are bonded with an adult who is involved in their well-being is less likely to engage in risky behaviors?

Parents, did you know that being involved and promoting activities in the lives of adolescents help them to learn to explore and engage in new ventures?

Did you also know that health behaviors in childhood are dominated by parental instruction and shared family values?

How can we communicate better and become more involved?

- 1. **LISTEN. Parents,** sit quietly and let your child express themselves without interruption.

- 3. **HAVE PATIENCE.** Agree to disagree and remain calm with all interactions. Promote positive understanding and limit conflict. Seek help and support if communication is failing.

College Spotlight: Spelman College

Located in Atlanta Georgia, Spelman College was founded in in 1881 as an Atlanta Baptist Female Seminary before becoming a college in 1924. The original founders of the seminary, Harriet Giles and Sophia Packard, impressed wealthy businessman John D. Rockefeller who ended up funding the oldest building on campus today, Rockefeller Hall, which was constructed in 1886. Spelman has over 2,400 students and Spelman's nickname is the Jaguars. Spelman's motto is "Our whole school for Christ." Some of Spelman's famous alumni are Stacey Abrams, Alice Walker, Lisa Cook, and Marian Edelman.


